Qualifying applicants are determined solely by the total number of Academic and Bonus Points earned, with no consideration given to résumés or letters of recommendation.

VIDEO INTERVIEW POINTS

Video Interview

Maximum Points: 25

Qualifying applicants will receive detailed information about the program and instructions for submitting a Video Interview during the Radiography Qualifying Applicant Orientation.

Video Interviews will be scored based on the following criteria: preparation, communication skills, content relevance, clarity of delivery, professionalism, and healthcare-related service experience.

VIDEO INTERVIEW POINTS

Total # of Points Available: 25

The top-ranked qualifying applicants (up to 33) will be offered a position in the Radiography Program beginning in the upcoming summer semester. Qualifying applicants are determined by the total number of Video Interview, Academic, and Bonus Points earned.

Applicants who accept their offer will be required to attend the Radiography New Student Bootcamp, held prior to the start of the summer semester.

Additional top-ranked applicants (up to 6) may be offered an alternate* position.

(*Being named an alternate does not guarantee placement in the Radiography Program. If a position does not become available, alternates interested in the program will need to reapply for the next application cycle.)
